There will be guest speakers, who have dedicated their lives to helping us find our loved ones. If you would like to speak about your missing family member that would be wonderful! Please contact Susan or Darlene if you are interested in speaking. Each family member will receive 15 minutes to speak. A press release will be sent out regarding this service. An area will be set aside for families to bring large posters of their missing loved ones to be put on display as a backdrop in the press area. There will be a reception after the service and at that time the press will be invited to talk to the families of the missing. Due to the election year, invitations to this event will be extended to many politicians in Maryland. Please forward the attached flier to your family and friends, and local police. Numbers Speak Loudly! Let us share together both the sad and joyful times we shared with our loved ones! Let our voices be heard loud and clear by politicians, police and our communities.
